PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT IN MURRAYSBURG: LABOUR CONTENT

Tenders are hereby invited for the labour content for the construction of Public Transport Infrastructure in Murraysburg. The work entails the construction of pedestrian sidewalks.

TENDER CONDITIONS:

1. It is a requirement that tenderers are registered with SARS as a business and that a tax clearance certificate and proof of registration on the Database of the Beaufort West Municipality must be provided with the completed tender documentation. Only tenderers based within the borders of the Beaufort West Municipality will be allowed to tender.
2. Tender documents will only be available at the compulsory site inspection in Murraysburg. Prospective tenderers must book their tender documents 2 days before the site inspections at the Department of Civil Engineering Services (tel. 023-4148102).
3. A non-refundable tender deposit of R114.00, payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of Beaufort West Municipality, is required on collection of the tender documents. Electronic payment details are Beaufort West Municipality, ABSA Bank, account nr. 4050538936, branch code 632005, current or cheque account.
4. Tenders may only be submitted on the tender document that is issued. All information on the preferential points claim form and terms of reference must be completed. Prospective tenderers of which the preferential points claim form and terms of reference are not completed, will not be considered for preferential and terms of reference points.
5. A valid, Original Income Tax Clearance Certificate, obtainable from SARS, as well as proof of payment of regional services levies must accompany the tender.

7. **A compulsory site/information session will be held on 20 October 2011, at 15:00 at the Municipal Offices in Murraysburg. All prospective tenderers are to meet at the said date, time and place.**

The tender must be placed in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on the outside with the tender number, project name and directed to The Municipal Manager, and deposited in the official tender box, at 112 Donkin Street, Beaufort West, before closing time on closing date. Office hours: 07:30 to 16:00, Monday to Friday.
9. The tender closure date and time, shall be **Friday 04 November 2011 at 14:00.**
10. All prices tendered must include VAT.
11. Tenders will be opened in the Conference room, Municipal Offices, 112 Donkin Street, Beaufort West in public, immediately after the closing time at 14:00..
12. Tenders not conforming to the aforementioned conditions shall be rejected.
13. The lowest or any tender shall not necessarily be accepted and the Council reserves the right to accept any part of a tender.
14. The tender shall be evaluated and allocated in terms of the Council's Supply Chain Management and Procurement Policy.
