### UPGRADING OF THE MERWEVILLE WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS

The contract comprises the construction of a new oxidation pond, inlet works and accompanying pipework.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE Class of construction works and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25(1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, 2004. The estimate for the contract lies within the range R2,000,000 to R4,000,000 (Grading designation 4).

Preferences are offered to tenderers who satisfy criteria stated in the Tender Data.

Only tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders.
