UPGRADING OF THE MURRAYSBURG WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS

Bids are invited by the Municipal Manager of BEAUFORT WEST MUNICIPALITY for the upgrading of the Murraysburg Wastewater Treatment Works.

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a **CE** class of construction works and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with regulation 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, 2004. It is estimated that tenderers will need a grading designation of **5CE or higher**.

Bid documents will only be available at the compulsory clarification meeting. Prospective bidders must book their documents 2 days before the clarification meeting at Tel. No. 021-950 7500. A non-refundable fee of R350.00 is payable for a set of documents. The fee must be deposited into the account of the **Beaufort West Municipality** at **NEDBANK**, Branch Code: **198 765**, Account Number: **107 428 0318**. The reference number for confirmation of payment is: **10/10000/100/020110** and bid documents will be made available upon provision of proof of payment.

A compulsory site clarification meeting with the representatives of the Beaufort West Municipality and Consultants will be held at the Beaufort West Municipality, Engineering Services (61 Bird Street) on Thursday 30 June 2016, at 11:00. A representative may only represent one Tenderer at the meeting.

Bids in sealed envelopes endorsed "**SCM 35/2016: Upgrading of the Murraysburg Wastewater Treatment Works**" to be deposited in the **Tender box** at the office of the **DIRECTOR: CORPORATE SERVICES**, at the **Sanlam Building, 112 DONKIN STREET, Beaufort West, 6970** to reach the undersigned by not later than **14:00 on FRIDAY, 15 July 2016**, on which date bids received will be opened in the Committee Room of the Beaufort West Municipality. Any person desiring to be present may attend.

The tender must be valid for a period of 90 days after the closing date. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted. The lowest, only or any bid shall not necessarily be accepted and the Council reserves the right to accept any part of the bid. The preference point system applicable is 90/10.

NOTE: This tender will be evaluated in terms of the revised Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 that was promulgated by the Minister of Finance on 8 June 2011 in Government Gazette No 34350.

PROCUREMENT PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEM: 90/10

The successful bidder will be required to complete and sign a written Contract Form.

The following conditions to bid exist:
(Failure to comply may result in your bid being disqualified)

1. This bid is subject to the General Conditions of contract for Construction works (GCC), special conditions of CIDB and Supply Chain Management special conditions for bidding.
2. Relevant specifications.

3. Bidders must be registered on the Beaufort West Municipality supplier database if they wish to conduct business with Beaufort West Municipality.
4. A valid or certified tax clearance certificate must be submitted with the closing of the bid. Alternatively, bidders may supply their Tax Compliance Status electronic access PIN to view compliance status online.
5. Bids submitted must be in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the bid number, placed in the tender box before closing time; failure to comply will result in the bid declared invalid.
6. The bid must be valid for a period of 12 weeks (90 days) after the closing date. The bid will be subject to Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011.
7. Bids will be assessed based on functionality. Bidders will be awarded functionality points based on the organisation and staffing of their proposed project team, experience of key staff and experience of the tenderer with similar type of work. The weighted average should be a minimum of 70 in order to be further evaluated in terms of the preference points system.

Functionality points will be awarded based on the following technical criteria:

- Tenderer has completed a contract which included de-sludging of ponds with an area of at least 7000 m²
- Tenderer has completed a contract which included reinforced concrete structures
- Tenderer has experience in installing HDPE pipes up to 200 mm diameter
