The BEAUFORT WEST MUNICIPALITY hereby invites suitably qualified contractors to submit tenders for the Reseal of Roads. The resealing is approximately 20 000 m² that includes for preparation of road surface by crack sealing and pothole repair.

It is estimated that the contractor should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 4CE or 4SB higher. A prerequisite of 75% exist for functionality.

Documents will only be available for collection at the compulsory site inspection meeting if tenderers booked their tender documents 2 days in advance before the site inspection. Bids will then be opened in the presence of anyone who wishes to attend, in the Committee Room in the Sanlam Building, 112 Donkin Street, Beaufort West.

A compulsory site inspection meeting will be held at the Office of Director Engineering Services at 61 Bird Street in Beaufort West at 14:00 on 28 October 2015, where representatives of the Employer will take the prospective tenderers to the site of the works. No tenderers will be allowed to attend the compulsory site inspection meeting after 14:10.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted. The lowest, only or any bid shall not necessarily be accepted and the Council reserves the right to accept any part of the bid.

The bid must be valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days after the closing date. The bid will be subject to Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011.
